PERDIGUIER PROGRAMME

UNIVERSITY OF AVIGNON SCHOLARSHIPS INTERNATIONAL MOBILITY PROGRAMME FOR DOCTORAL STUDENTS

Objective

Support for the international mobility of doctoral students enrolled at the University of Avignon. This concerns doctoral students (without joint supervision) registered at the University of Avignon who wish to carry out a research trip of at least 2 months at a host institution abroad. Please note that foreign doctoral students going on mobility to their country of origin are not eligible. Three application sessions will be organised per academic year.

Terms and conditions of award

- Applicants must be in the 1st, 2nd or 3rd year of their thesis when they apply. Doctoral students entering their 4th year of study during the mobility period are not eligible.
- All fields of study and all destinations are accepted, EXCEPT for foreign doctoral students registered at the University of Avignon who wish to carry out a mobility programme in their country of origin.
- A lump-sum allowance of between 1500 and 4000 Euros is given. The amount of support granted is decided by the selection committee after reviewing the application.
- The selection committee is made up of the CED committee and a representative of the University's international relations department. It may draw on the advice of experts called upon from time to time.
- The allowance is paid in a single instalment, after the House of Research has received the certificate of arrival in the host research institute, signed by the local director.
- The grant can be cumulated with other forms of funding that may be granted to the doctoral student, but which must be explicitly mentioned in the application file.

The file to be submitted to the Directorate for Research and Innovation Support must include

- an application form duly completed and signed by the doctoral student and by the director of the relevant laboratory at the University of Avignon. It includes the research project, the candidate's CV, the mobility budget and a letter of support from the main thesis supervisor at the University of Avignon;
- a letter of invitation from the host institution (laboratory, department, institute, documentation centre, etc.).

At the end of the mobility, the selected doctoral students will have to provide a report of about 2 pages describing their stay and the scientific work carried out.
